Jose Luis González Uriol, born in Zaragoza (Spain), Professor of Organ and Harpsichord at the High School of Music from Zaragoza and performer of undisputed prestige, has a world-wide reputation as a specialist in Early Keyboard Music.

He pursued his musical studies under Prof. Montserrat Torrent (Barcelona), Macarío Santiago Kastner (Lisboa), and Gustav Leonhardt (Amsterdam).

His career as a concert performer has led him to take part in the most important International Festivals and Musical Centres in the five continents. As a specialist in Early Iberian Music he has made numerous recordings. He is titular organist of the Royal Chapel of Santa Isabel de Portugal and of the Historical "Jose de Sesma" Organ in the Renaissance Court, Patio de la Infanta, cofounder of the Department of Early Music in the Intitución Fernando el Católico (Zaragoza), director of the internacional Early Music Course and Festival at Daroca from 1979 as well as Counsellor Elect in the Consultant Council of the afore-mentioned Institution.

He has been awarded the Cross of Alfonso X el Sabio and of the Gold Medal of the Cortes de Aragón (the Aragonese Parliament) for his service to Music in that community. With his exceptional performance, he has marked the Closing Ceremony of our 2001 Festival and conducted a seminar for the pupils of the eight grade of the Croatian and Italian elementary schools in Umag, demonstrating them in a captivating way the possibilities of the queen of all musical instruments.
